Online Workshop: The First Sip



This design from Hazel's book, *Crewel Intentions*, measures 260 x 200 mm and is worked with a variety of both needle lace and weaving techniques. Along with those signature techniques, it includes the following:

Embroidery Stitches

Backstitch
Buttonhole stitch (with variations)
Chain stitch backstitch combination
Detached buttonhole stitch
Fly stitch (with variation)
French knots
Heavy chain stitch
Long and short stitch
Outline stitch
Padded satin stitch

Using perle, #80 and stranded cottons, rayon threads and Miyuki beads the project is worked on a winter white cotton linen blend fabric.

Participants will need to own the *Crewel Intentions* book. Other than the book, the kit contains everything that students will need to complete the design, as under.

The kit includes everything needed to complete the project as under:

- Print on cream cotton hopsack
- DMC/Anchor Threads:
 - 7 skeins stranded cotton
 - 2 skeins rayon thread
 - 9 bobbins Perle thread
 - 3 bobbins Lizbeth #80 thread
- Beads and Crystals
 - 3 packs Miyuki seed beads
- Needle Pack
- A teaching kit will also be provided.

Whether your group or guild has chosen to do the workshop with live sessions or if you are instead, doing the prerecorded online workshop, each stitch or technique is provided in video format on a template. A sheet of templates is provided for the workshop and should be used to learn the stitches or techniques before working on the project. In addition to the templates, each participant will be provided with a teaching pack. The teaching pack consists of a doodle cloth and a range of threads and beads for use while learning. This means that participants do not have to use threads and beads from the project pack.

If your group or guild chooses to do the workshop with live sessions, high resolution video clips for all the stitches and techniques are provided in an online private domain so that participants will be able to reference them between and after the live sessions. Access to this domain does not expire so that participants are not under pressure to finish the project within a designated time frame. Each participant will receive an access document by email.

Step by step instructions, along with colour images, diagrams and stitch guidelines are provided in the Crewel Intentions book. These instructions should be used in tandem with either the live sessions or the prerecorded video lessons.

Because of publishing contracts, participants will be required to own a copy of the Crewel Intentions book to access the written instructions. If any of the participants do not own the book, we should be informed and the necessary number of copies of the South African edition of Crewel Intentions will be included in your kit shipment.

Duration: 4 online live lessons plus ongoing access to the tuition page or 4 prerecorded lessons posted either weekly or monthly.

Level of Skill: Intermediate to advanced

Student Requirements:

- 6" hoop
- 14" hoop
- sharp scissors
- notebook and pen or pencil
- good spectacles or additional magnification, if required.
