Long & Short Stitch Shading
(fanned and diagonal)

There are two variations of long and short stitch shading in the video clip above. They are listed in the table below, in the order in which they appear, with the starting time for each variety in the right-hand column.

Vertical (fanned) long and short stitch shading	4 minutes
Diagonal long and short stitch shading	15 minutes 29 seconds

Interlace Chain Stitch

This difficult stitch has been described, step by step, in the long and short stitch video clip on this website. It is worth watching this video clip because it gives you tips that will help you to improve your long and short stitch shading.

Knotted Cable Chain Stitch

For maximum clarity, the sample in the above video was worked with perle #5 thread.

Satin Stitch - Basic

There are numerous variations of satin stitch in the video clip above. They are listed in the table below, in the order in which they appear, with the starting time for each variety in the right-hand column. You would usually work satin stitch with a single strand of stranded cotton. For the sake of clarity, the sample has been worked with perle #5 thread.

Padded (fanned) chain stitch	22 seconds
Vertical Satin Stitch	3 minutes 19 seconds
Small Satin Stitch	10 minutes 49 seconds
Satin Stitch Leaf	15 minutes 24 seconds
Satin Stitch Blocks	15 minutes 24 seconds

Satin Stitch

padded fanned satin stitch
vertical satin stitch
diagonal satin stitch
small satin stitch leaf
satin stitch blocks

Interlace Chain Stitch

Work with 1 strand of thread.
Starting in the middle of the shape working first to the right, and then through the darkest colour at the base first.

Satin Stitch

To fill. This ladder of stitches forms the basis of this technique.
