4-Online Live Session Workshop: Contemporary Crewelwork Birds (Eagle and Bluebird)

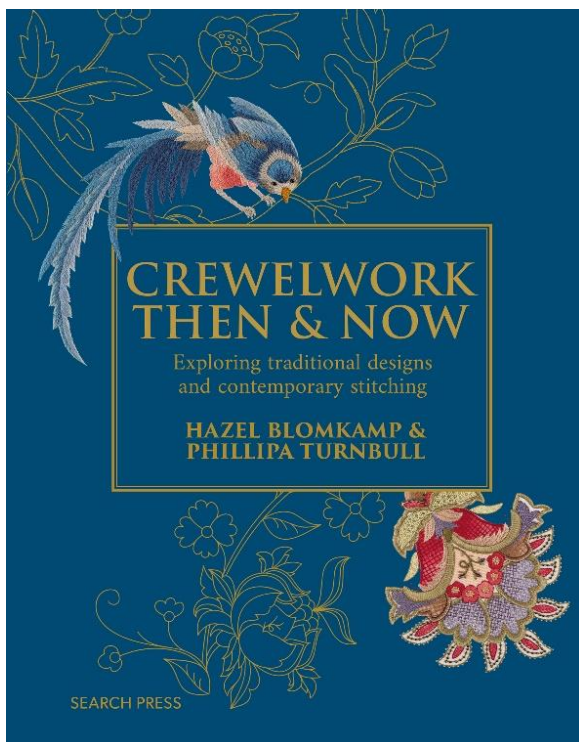

Each measuring 310 x 250 mm (12¼ x 9 inches) the Contemporary Crewelwork birds are a modern take on historical designs and feature with their traditional counterparts in Crewelwork Then and Now by Hazel Blomkamp and Phillipa Turnbull.



These projects are worked with conventional surface embroidery stitches and a variety of interesting needle work techniques that have been modified for use as embroidery stitches, all of which are listed below. The originals have been backed and sandwiched with polyester batting and made into cushions. Participants can choose whether they wish to do that or not because they can also be framed.

Both projects will be taught online in 4 x 4-hour live sessions. In both instances, there will be ongoing online access to the stitches and techniques after the event.

Because of publishing contracts, participants in this workshop will be required to have the book, Crewelwork Then and Now to access the stitching instructions. It will be available from regular or online booksellers. Currently, the pre-order price for this book is US\$40.00 (± CA\$55.00)

Project Description:

The projects are worked on Ecreu-coloured cotton twill.

Step by step instructions, along with colour images, diagrams and stitch guidelines are provided in the Crewelwork Then and Now book. Classwork will be done on a doodle cloth with additional threads and beads. High resolution video clips for all the stitches and techniques that are taught in the workshop will be provided in the online private domain so that participants will be able to reference them after the event.



Kit Descriptions:

The project kits contain everything that students will need to complete the embroidery panels, as under.

- *Print on Ecreu-coloured cotton twill backed with cotton voile and overlocked around the edges*
- *Threads*
 - *24 skeins DMC stranded cotton*
 - *14 bobbins Finca Perle cotton*
- *Miyuki Beads*
 - *5 x 2-gram packs seed beads*
- *Needle Pack*

Bluebird

- *Print on Ecreu-coloured cotton twill backed with cotton voile and overlocked around the edges*
- *Threads*
 - *24 skeins DMC stranded cotton*
 - *10 bobbins Finca Perle cotton*
- *Miyuki Beads*
 - *4 x 2-gram packs seed beads*
- *Needle Pack*

In addition to the full project kits, participants will be provided with a teaching kit.



Duration: 4 x 4-hour live sessions online with ongoing access to the online tuition page for this workshop.

Level of Skill: Intermediate to Advanced

Student Requirements:

- 6" hoop for class work
- 16 x 14" stretcher bars, or a 14" hoop (for each project)
- sharp scissors
- good spectacles or additional magnification, if required.
